To ensure an organized parade, we will charge a late fee of \$25 for any application turned in after June 17 and we will have to place the entry at the end of the parade.

BRANDON INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION

PARADE RULES

- 1. Participants will be lined up by 12 noon and begin marching at 1:00.
- 2. The overall height of an entry can be no more than 13', measured from the road up and including the height of the vehicle.
- 3. If you are marching with animals, someone must be designated to clean up after them and to maintain control at all times.
- 4. No items can be thrown by walkers or from floats. Instead, items may be distributed to viewers by helpers alongside the parade route.
- 5. Emergency vehicles and crews that participate in the parade will be off-duty and not required to respond to an emergency on the date of the parade between 12:00 noon and 3:00 p.m.
- 6. The driver of a motor vehicle or float in the parade must have the appropriate current motor vehicle license and carry liability insurance in an amount adequate to cover property damage and/or personal injury; the vehicle must be registered and insured.

WAIVER OF RESPONSIBILITY

The signer hereof, individually and on behalf of his/her entire group, including all participants, successors, assigns and representatives, hereby agrees as follows:

- 1. to indemnify, to abide by all applicable municipal and state laws and ordinances;
- to assume any and all risks to myself and the entire group, including all participants, successors, assigns and representatives, and to any personal property used by any of the foregoing in the Parade;
- 3. defend and hold harmless the Brandon Independence Day Celebration Committee, Parade sponsors, officers and volunteers from any and all claims, losses, liabilities, and/or expenses caused by or otherwise arising out of the Parade.
