  - a. Updating of NR Survey of Brandon Village Historic District Blaine has completed a third of the survey. Blaine will be gone for two weeks but we will start doing a deed search and examining the town upon his return as well as going over historic maps. The starting point is the information about Brandon in The Historic Architecture of Rutland County. Something to explore are the various cemeteries – particularly the Catholic Cemetery.
  - b. Adding state historic districts to NR: Forest Dale, Rossiter Street, etc.
  - c. Revising existing NR to include French/Canadian Historic District
  - d. Complete barn survey (query Kevin Thornton)
  - e. Continue quarry survey and submit for a noncontiguous quarry historic district
  - f. Prepare list of grants for which the town can apply to cover future expenses
  - g. Any additional items
  - h. Historical Markers:
    - Conant/Howe Scale furnace site
