- **Free of Charge.** Items accepted include glass, aluminum, tin, plastic 1&2, plastic 3-7, newspaper, magazines, cardboard, boxboard.

- Under 16" **\$3.00**
- 16" – 36" **\$6.00**
- 36" – 52" **\$15.00**
- Over 52" **\$45.00**

Household

Bagged household trash

- 0 – 16 lbs **2.50** flat minimum charge
- Over 16 lbs **add \$.15/lb**
- Porcelain, plastics, rugs **\$.13/lb**
- Appliances With Freon: Refrigerator **\$15.00 each**, Freezers **\$15.00 each**, Air conditioners **\$15.00 each**
- Furniture: Mattresses, box springs **\$15.00** each piece, **\$5.00** crib size, Couches: **\$20.00**, Recliners: **\$15.00**

Biodegradable

Biodegradable material such as grass, leaves, compost, and untreated/unpainted wood are taken free of charge.

Construction Materials & Tanks

- Grindable Materials: **\$55.00** per yard (Sheetrock, shingles, wood, plaster, tile)
- Sorted Asphalt: **\$45.00** per yard
- Helium Tanks: **\$2.00** ea.
- Propane tanks: **\$10.00** per 20 lb tank
- **\$1.00** smaller tanks; (*LP gas tanks and cylinders only; 20 lb size limit.*)
- Fluorescent bulbs **\$.25 per ft.**
- Batteries: car/truck **\$5.00**; Motorcycle **\$3.00**, Small (power tool) **\$1.00**, Rechargeable **\$.25 each**
- Motor oil is accepted free of charge

Hazardous waste days occur three times per year, a free service, and dates are posted at the transfer station.

Scrap metal is free of charge
