3. Approval of Application

a. Application #S-000009696, Retailers – Lovely Cannabis LLC

Tim Guiles asked if the Town receives a fee for the applications. Seth Hopkins has been in communication with the State. He provided a list of local approvals compared to the payments received from the State. The State will be forwarding the Town \$100 for each license that has been approved.

4. Public Comment and Participation

Neil Silins stated there was a previous conversation about a limit on the number of cannabis licenses approved and noted he has read that the rate of licenses issued has been decreasing as the market is being saturated. Seth Hopkins reported the State will be suspending issuances of new retail licenses as it is realized that there is a market oversaturation risk.
